Description

Action is a fine white powder which releases vapors that preserve, deodorize, and create firmness. It will also achieve this effect by direct contact.

Features

The active vapors are released more rapidly at higher temperatures, so Action will work best under warm conditions. Action should always be used in an enclosed or wrapped environment so all vapors are used to maximum advantage.

IMPORTANT: When shipping a body that has been treated with Action, note on transit papers that the receiving funeral director should allow an hour or two to open the casket and air it out.

Applications

Use Action for wet or dry floaters when hypo treatment cannot be done. It is also excellent when arterial work is precluded in such cases of trauma and mutilation as auto accidents, plane crashes, and fires. Approximately two pounds of Action should be placed with the body inside the pouch.

Cancer, putrefaction, bedsores, and similar problem areas will all respond well to treatment with Action. Apply the powder to the area and wrap so vapors won't escape. Edematous limbs can be treated in the same manner and covered with plastic undergarments.

Use Action inside caskets and grave vaults, crypts, and mausoleums. Also valuable for disinterred cases and infants. Some embalmers will prefer using Action on autopsied bodies rather than Hardening Compound and a cavity chemical or Viscerock.
